At Fortec United States Corp, we are committed to responsible business practices and compliance with applicable regulations, including California's Proposition 65 and emerging regulations related to Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS).

Proposition 65 (Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986):

Because our products are sourced through a global supply chain, we do not always receive complete information from our suppliers regarding the presence of Proposition 65-listed substances. As a result, we cannot certify that all Fortec United States products are free of such substances. Where appropriate, products may carry Proposition 65 warnings to help ensure compliance and transparency.

PFAS (Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances):

Similarly, while Fortec United States Corp is monitoring regulatory developments related to PFAS, our suppliers do not consistently provide confirmation regarding PFAS content in materials or components. Therefore, we cannot guarantee that our products are free of PFAS. We remain committed to working with our partners to identify safer alternatives where feasible and to align with evolving regulations and industry best practices.

- Monitoring regulatory changes and industry standards related to Proposition 65 and PFAS.
- Communicating openly with customers about the information available to us.
- Encouraging suppliers to improve transparency regarding regulated substances.
- Continuing to review our practices as new scientific and regulatory information becomes available.
